The Neurological Impact of Substance Use/Disorder on the Brain

This seminar will examine the neurological changes that occur in the brain as a result of substance use and substance use disorders and the short and long-term effects on the mental health of the individual. The connection between psychological trauma and substance use will be covered as well as the neurological changes that occur with different categories of substances. Useful assessment tools, interventions and treatment options will be provided.

At conclusion, attendees should be able to:

- Explain the connection between psychological trauma and substance abuse;
- Describe neurological changes in the brain that occur with substance abuse throughout the life span;
- List common co-occurring mental illness that accompany substance abuse;
- Use a trauma-informed approach when working with clients.

Featured Presenter:

Brian R. Sims, M.D., is the Senior Director of Medical and Behavioral Health for the National Association of State Mental Health Program Directors. He is also a Senior Consultant for the National Center for Trauma Informed Care (NCTIC) where he provides lectures and trainings both nationally and internationally on the practice of Trauma-Informed Care and the neurobiology of trauma. He has been the lead consultant for Trauma Informed Care in the Faith Based community. Dr. Sims is a former staff psychiatrist with Correctional Mental Health Services, an organization serving the mental health needs of inmates in 60 detention centers in 10 states, where he was responsible for the provision of care for more than 3,000 inmates. Before joining Correctional Mental Health Care Services, he was the Senior Director for Behavioral and Mental Health for Conmed Healthcare Management where he was responsible for the development of core strategic planning for the company's correctional mental health provisions in 8 states. Prior to his work with Conmed, Dr. Sims served with the State mental health system for 25 years and maintained a private practice for 10 years. Dr. Sims also previously served in the U.S. Army Reserve at Walter Reed working with soldiers with PTSD.

The University's Center for Professional & Continuing Studies is located at 5350 Spectrum Drive, in the I-270 Technology Park, just south of the Francis Scott Key Mall.

The Center can be conveniently accessed from all points and directions in the greater Frederick region, via I-270, I-70, Rt. 355, Rt. 85, and downtown Frederick.

From Baltimore:

Take I-70 W to EXIT 54- (Rt 85, East St, Buckeystown, Downtown Frederick). Bear left at light onto Rt 85 S. At the intersection Rt. 85 & 355, turn left onto 355 S. Go 1.5 mi., turn right onto Holiday Drive. At traffic circle, proceed to the third exit (Spectrum Drive). Mount St. Mary's will be the first building on the right.

From Washington DC/Northern Virginia:

Take I-270 N to EXIT 31A (Rt. 85 North, Market St.) At the first light (Spectrum Drive) turn right. Proceed along Spectrum Drive to the traffic circle and take the second exit. Mount St. Mary's will be the first building on the right.



From Leesburg, Virginia and Maryland south of Frederick:

Take Rt. 15 to Rt. 340 N. Take I-270 S to EXIT 31A. Follow DC directions.

From Gettysburg, PA:

Take Rt. 15 S and bear left onto I-270 to EXIT 31A. Follow DC directions.

From Hagerstown, MD:

Take I-70 E to EXIT 54. Follow Baltimore directions.

From Downtown Frederick:

Take Market St. (Rt. 85) S toward Buckeystown/Urbana. At traffic light follow Rt. 355 S. Go 1.5 mi.

Turn right onto Holiday Drive. At traffic circle, proceed to the third exit (Spectrum Drive). Mount St. Mary's will be the first building on the right.
