The Hemingway Curse: A Study in Family Depression, Substance Abuse & Suicide

Friday, May 19, 2017

Following a lengthy history of alcohol abuse, Ernest Hemingway committed suicide in 1961. Six other members of the Hemingway family committed suicide before and after his death. The dynamics of the Hemingway multigenerational family history will be used in this seminar as a template for exploring the DSM-5 depressive disorders and related conditions, co-occurring illnesses, substance abuse and suicide within families. Seminar content will include evidence-based aspects of the heritable and environmental origins of depressive illness, exploration of documented suicide risk factors, acute illness intervention factors, evidence-based individual and family interventions, and suicide prevention strategies.

At the conclusion, attendees will be able to:

- Evaluate environmental influences vs. genetic factors in depression and suicide;
- Recognize the impact of depression, substance abuse, and depression on family members;
- Develop detailed assessment questions to identify familial risk factors;
- Utilize evidence-based intervention strategies for depression, substance abuse, and suicide behavior.

Dr. Carlton Munson, PhD, LCSW-C is a professor at the University of Maryland School of Social Work and director of the Washington Area Supervision Institute at Woodstock Forest. He is the author of 7 books and 79 journal articles and book chapters. His books, *Handbook for Clinical Social Work Supervision*, *The Mental Health Diagnostic Desk Reference*, and *Social Work Supervision* have been widely adopted as texts in the U.S. and abroad. Dr. Munson participated in the American Psychiatric Association field trials for the *DSM-5* and is currently working on a new edition of his book for use with the *DSM-5*. Dr. Munson was the clinician in a precedent setting Maryland Court of Appeals case that affirmed the right of licensed clinical social workers to perform DSM diagnoses, to testify as experts, and to testify to ultimate issues. This case has had national implications for the practice of clinical social work. He was also the clinician in two other Maryland Court of Appeals child welfare cases. He began his professional career as a clinical social worker at Brook Lane.

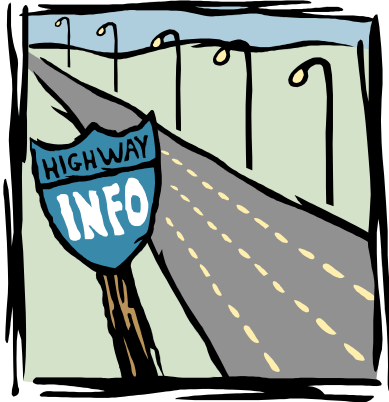
