**Brook Lane Staff: Follow Training procedures**

It is estimated that between 30-40% of incarcerated individuals have a diagnosed mental health disorder. Mental health providers are increasingly being asked to testify in court as their clients initiate or respond to legal proceedings. It is important for the clinician to understand proceedings and how to appropriately respond to assure the most factual exchange of information. This seminar will walk through the legal issues associated with a court-involved client's mental health treatment and offer valuable tips for the clinician who may be asked to be a part of the process.

- Explain how an individual's mental health status influences court proceedings;
- Summarize the role of attorneys, prosecutors and judges when a client is court-involved;

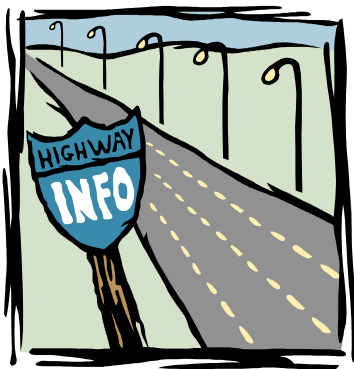
