Course Description:

This informative and interactive workshop will provide participants with concepts and interventions to promote healthier relationships within family systems experiencing infidelity, betrayal, divorce, or the blending of families. Tools and resources from attachment-based models, such as Emotionally Focused Therapy and Connected Recovery Model will be shared and highlighted. Case examples and mindfulness techniques will be used or discussed throughout the course to illustrate interventions that promote healing, safety, and connection within couples and families.

Participant Learning Objectives:

- Assist couples in healing and reconnecting after infidelity or betrayal using attachmentbased models.
- Learn interventions to combat shame, promote emotional safety, and communicate boundaries in couples.
- Help increase healthy communication and parenting skills with divorced parents and support children adjusting to two homes.
- Identify the challenges of working with blended families, understanding these family cycles, and helping grow family connections.
